Features and inclusions:

- All bookings are secured with payment in-full
- Final payments are non-refundable, but bookings are eligible for reschedule at the discretion of About Your Dog
- Customers are eligible to cancel and receive 50% back with 6 weeks notice
- Customers agree to put About Your Dog in contact with the venue/wedding co-ordinator at least 3 months prior to the event
- About Your Dog will not attend an outdoor event with your dog if the temperature exceeds 25 degrees C (50% of your payment will be refunded)
- About Your Dog will not use aversive equipment under any circumstances (including but not limited to slip leads, prong collars, e-collars) and you are required to provide a flat lead and collar
- **About Your Dog is happy to accommodate behaviour problems provided the dog is not a risk to people, or to themselves (e.g. aggression to people is not suitable)

Your dog's welfare is my priority, so I will always be vocal about ways we can best accommodate them!
